Learn How the City Works: Philomath Citizens' Academy Open for Registration



The City will be hosting its third Philomath Citizens' Academy beginning September 11th. Sessions will be held each Wednesday for eight weeks from 6-8 PM and will cover topics such as: local government organization, budgeting and finance, public works and utilities, police department and municipal court, long term planning and building permits, and urban renewal. The Philomath Fire District, Philomath School District, and the Philomath Library will also present.

Sessions will include tours of the police station, fire station, and the water treatment plant and school district offices. The final session will include presentations from various community organizations such as Philomath Community Services, PYAC, Benton County Historical Museum, and Strengthening Rural Families.

Current Philomath City Councilor Chas Jones described his experience with the Academy: "Philomath's Citizen's Academy is a relatively unique opportunity for community members to learn more about what makes our City tick. In 2018, I attended the Academy and found myself having a much better understanding of our community, and the public servants that add so much value to Philomath. Through the Academy, I learned about our schools, library, and nonprofit organizations; Fire and Police Departments; and our existing infrastructure systems. Personally, I found a lot of value in the Citizen's Academy and believe that many Philomath residents would enjoy taking a little deep dive into the community that they call home."


