MINUTES REVIEW & APPROVAL:

STATISTICS - Chief Rueben handed out a stat sheet and explained the stats. Explained how “charges” vs. “arrests” affect the statistics. Philomath Police Department counts each arrest not each charge. Stats are hard to assess because case follow up can produce more “charges”. There are many factors to the stats.

RECENT CASE BRIEFING – Chief Rueben gave updates on recent burglary case. Search warrants produced drugs and stolen property. Odometer case has produced additional information and Chief should have and update in 3 to 4 months.

CIT TRAINING - Crisis Intervention Training: 40 hour training course that all PPD officers must attend. De-escalation training course focusing on mental health issues/care. The focus of material may not apply to most of PPD. Small portion of course is on mental health and care in relation to Police interaction.

ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING UPDATE - Fire Department and Police Department have met and are going through Fire strategy vs Police strategy and protocol. Chief went over diagram on the white board. Talked about tactical priorities and how the Fire and Police can best work together in case of emergency. They are working on a flow chart of priorities for Fire chief to enact once on scene. Training is happening in July. Date TBA.

SCHOLORSHIPS - 6 Scholarship applications were received. 2 of those met all the critical requirements. Those have been forwarded to Bob Boss for review.

OPEN DISCUSSION - Next meeting will be scheduled at a later time.

-Adair Police Department has equipment and supplies that may be for sale. Philomath Police Department might be interested in depending on cost.
