CITY COUNCIL ELECTION FILING PERIOD OPENING

At the November 6, 2018 General Election, the positions of Philomath Mayor and all six City Council positions will appear on the ballot. The filing period for interested candidates begins June 11th. The filing process, including signature verification, must be completed by August 28, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

All positions on the Philomath City Council are for two years and begin on January 14, 2019. Council positions are elected at large, meaning candidates may reside in any area within the city limits. The six Council candidates receiving the most votes are elected.

To qualify as a candidate for Mayor or City Council, you must be:

- qualified elector within the meaning of the state constitution of the state of Oregon; and
- be a resident of the city of Philomath during the six months immediately preceding the election.

Interested citizens should contact the City Elections Official, Ruth Post, to determine if they meet the qualifications and residency requirements and to learn more about the expectations of serving on the City Council.
