Register for Philomath Citizens' Academy

The City will be hosting a Philomath Citizens' Academy beginning September 5th. Sessions will be held each Wednesday for eight weeks from 6-8 PM and will cover topics such as: local government organization, budgeting and finance, public works and utilities, police department and municipal court, long term planning and building permits, and urban renewal. The Philomath Fire District, Philomath School District, and the Philomath Library will also present.

Sessions will include tours of the police station, fire station, and the water treatment plant and school district offices. The final session will include presentations from various community organizations such as Philomath Community Services, PYAC, Benton County Historical Museum, and Strengthening Rural Families.

The Citizens' Academy is a great way to learn more about community organizations, find ways to get involved and help make a difference in your community.
