

New Alert System Available

On November 28, the water pressure dropped during a main line repair causing some residents to experience low water flows and others no water at all. A loss in water pressure creates the potential for untreated water to enter the system. Due to the extent of areas effected by the pressure drop, a boil water notice was issued city-wide until water quality tests could be completed.

The City used a variety of methods to inform the public of the boil water notice including notifying the press and the Chamber of Commerce, posting on the City's Facebook page and directy calling area restaurants. The City also notified Benton County Emergency Services.

Linn-Benton ALERT Emergency Notification System is a mass notification system that allows public safety officials to provide rapid notifications of emergencies, evacuations, and other urgent events via phone. By signing up, you can receive time-sensitive emergency and safety alerts from public safety officials. You choose how and where to receive alerts, including your cell, home, and/or work phone, by email, text message, or TTY (hearing impaired devices) and more. 

