Sewer unit charges for commercial, industrial, and multi-residential customers are billed based on actual water usage. Customers who irrigate may request summer averaging.

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Street Utility Fee

All developed properties within the City limits are charged a monthly fee for maintenance and repair of the City street system. Non-residential properties are placed into a category, calculations for each category can be found in Resolution 03-13.

Storm Drain Fee

All customers within the City limits are charged a monthly fee for maintenance and repair of storm sewer facilities. Commercial, industrial and multi-residential rates are calculated based on the square footage of impervious surface.

Application for Service:

Payments: Accounts with a 30-day balance are subject to a 1½% per month late fee. Accounts are delinquent if not paid within 45 days. If an account becomes delinquent, and a shutoff notice is delivered, there will be a \$10 fee added to the account. If payment is not received as required on the shutoff notice, the water will be shut off and a \$30 service fee will be added to the account. The minimum payment plus the \$40 fee must be paid before the water service will be turned back on.

Disputes: If you dispute the accuracy of the billing, you must present your objection within fifteen (15) days after the date of your bill. Failure to file a notice of objection to the billing shall constitute a waiver of your right to object.

Underground Leaks: If you have a leak in a pipe between the meter and the building, repair it promptly and notify the Water Department. You may be eligible for an adjustment of up to 50% of the water that was lost. Sewer charges may be adjusted for those customers billed on actual units.

Standard Discharge Strength: Monthly volume charges for Standard Discharge Strength commercial and industrial users shall be computed by multiplying actual metered water usage in 100 cubic foot units by \$5.00. Where the customer in the commercial and industrial classes can demonstrate to the satisfaction of City staff that the volume of sewer discharge does not equal the water volume used because some or all of the water used is not being discharged into the sewer systems, the City may determine the appropriate amount of charges based upon the City's estimate of actual amount of sewer discharge.

Non-Standard Discharge Strength: Per unit charge for users in the Non-Standard Discharge Strength customer class shall be the actual cost of treating the extra strength wastewater. The per unit charge to be determined by the City prior to the user discharging to the sewerage system.
